An awareness programme on recycling of waste water, water harvesting for agriculture/horticulture application/kitchen gardens was organized in Kachhwa village, Haryana on 28th December, 2021. During this event CSSRI officials visited the primary school of this village where children's and staff members were provided with knowledge about the utilization of wastewater. Wastewater is being treated and recycled within residential compounds for applications such as for irrigation in agriculture, landscaping such as parks, indoor uses such as toilet flushing, dust control or surface cleaning of roads, construction sites, and other trafficked areas, concrete mixing and other construction processes, supplying artificial lakes and inland or coastal aquifers and overall environmental restoration etc. Rainwater harvest from a particular area provides water for human, animal, or agriculture use.
