

ICAR-CSSRI Karnal Organizes Agricultural Input Distribution and Kisan Goshthi on Balanced Fertilization under SCSP on 09.04.2026

ICAR-Central Soil Salinity Research Institute (CSSRI), Karnal successfully organized an Agricultural Input Distribution Programme along with a Kisan Goshthi on “Balanced Fertilization Practices” for Scheduled Caste (SC) farmers under the SCSP on 09.04.2026. The programme was conducted under the guidance of Dr. S.K. Sanwal, Director of the Institute, with active support from Dr. Satyendra Kumar, Head and Dr. Ajay Kumar Bhardwaj, Chairman, SCSP. The programme was coordinated by Dr. B.L. Meena, Nodal Officer, SCSP.

The programme witnessed the participation of around 30 farmers, who were sensitized about the importance of balanced nutrient management for improving soil health and enhancing crop productivity, particularly under salt-affected conditions. Experts from the institute interacted with the farmers and highlighted practical strategies for efficient fertilizer use, soil testing, and sustainable agricultural practices.

During the programme, agricultural input kits were distributed to the participating farmers to support improved farming practices at the field level. The interactive session provided a platform for farmers to share their experiences and seek technical guidance from scientists.
